EMMA – ESPOO MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

JONATHAN MEESE, DANIEL RICHTER, TAL R: THE MEN WHO FELL FROM EARTH

Renewing the traditions of neo-expressionism, the trio now has their most extensive exhibition in Finland to date. The exhibition features installations co-created by the three artists, a video piece and an overview of each artist's recent work.

JUHANA MOISANDER: ETHOLOGY OF A MAN

Ethology of a Man looks at human group behaviour from a scientific and social perspective. Known for his spatially evocative media art, Moisander takes his work to a new monumental scale in this piece.

Take a look into the bold, ever-developing world of materials. The exhibition interweaves fibres, techniques, textures and diverse materials into a tapestry, fusing the legacy of contemporary art, ancient handicrafts, new technology and futuristic visions.

MICHAEL JACKSON: ON THE WALL

The main exhibition of the year brings together contemporary artists' interpretations of the phenomenon called Michael Jackson. The show features more than 40 international artists from Andy Warhol to Grayson Perry and Isa Genzken who have used their art to examine Jackson's impact on culture and our way of thinking.

PERMANENT EXHIBITION

TOUCH

A permanent exhibition displaying selected works from the Saastamoinen Foundation's art collection. With the overarching theme of humanity at its core, the Touch exhibition presents an extensive selection of contemporary works from Finland and abroad. This summer, the media space of the Touch exhibition features Pilvi Takala's Players (2010).

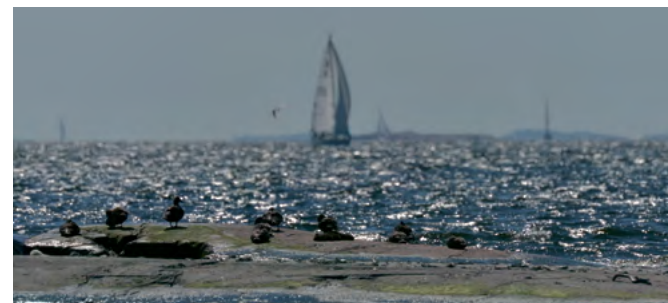
VISIBLE STORAGE OF BRYK & WIRKKALA

EYES ON THE HORIZON

Change the way you look at the sea! The activity-oriented exhibition tells about changes in maritime Espoo from the viewpoints of livelihoods, leisure and nature. Seascapes in different seasons and maritime items take the visitor to marine themes from fyke net fishing to birdwatching, from stormy seas to the cliffs on the Kivenlahti shore. You are invited to investigate, play, dive and fish!

PERMANENT EXHIBITION

A THOUSAND STORIES ABOUT ESPOO

The exhibition tells stories of Espoo in five eras and five locations: Stone Age seal hunters in Bosmalm, medieval farmers in Mankby, the gentry and common people in Alberga, factory workers in Kauklahti and city life in the suburbs. The exhibition also explains how Espoo was born, who the people living there are and how Espoo became the city it is today.

The permanent exhibition displays clocks and watches with focus on clocks and watches made or used in Finland. Dive into the currents of time!

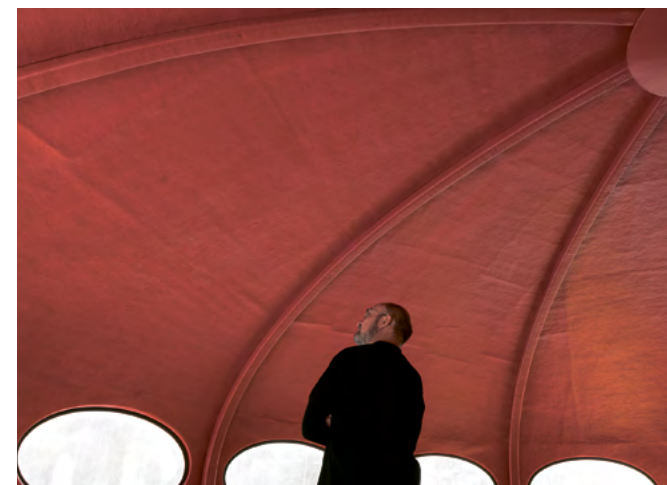

THE FUTURO HOUSE

The Futuro house at WeeGee, the first mass-produced Futuro house (no. 001) is open in the summer season.

The Futuro is a plastic house designed by architect Matti Suuronen. Elliptical in shape, the house captures the experimental forms, new materials and optimistic ideas of the space-age architecture and design of the late 1960s.

This work of art renowned in the field of visual arts across the globe. Only three Futuro houses are in public collections: the Futuro prototype (no. 000) at the Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen in Rotterdam, Futuro no. 001 at the Exhibition Centre WeeGee in Espoo and the third Futuro at the Die Neue Sammlung – The Design Museum in Munich.

FUTURO WORLD 50 YEARS

Studio Suuronen, Exhibition Centre WeeGee

The exhibition presents Futuro houses and their locations across the world through photographs, captions and map graphics. The exhibition contains photographs of 50 Futuro houses around the world. At the exhibition, visitors can also watch the documentary Futuro: A New Stance for Tomorrow (Director Mika Taanila, script Marko Home and Mika Taanila, Kinotar Oy, 1998). The exhibition is open whenever WeeGee is open, also on Mondays. Admission to Studio Suuronen is free of charge.
